From the Pastor's Desk

Today we hear Jesus saying farewell. Judah made the decision to betray his Master and consistently implemented it, ignoring and not counting on the clear and specific gestures of Jesus' love for him. The immediate student becomes a traitor. Judas rejects the love of Jesus so openly, but Jesus asks the other disciples to learn the new commandment of mutual love.

Jesus revealed the greatest love through His creation. He died on the cross for us. Jesus wanted to extinguish egoism and hatred in the heart of the individual man of faith, so that the kingdom of love could prevail in the world. The real reason for the present crisis in Christianity could have its source in the lack of authentic mutual love. Christian communities, families, and parishes do not always radiate evangelical love. A man looking from the outside has a hard time noticing that love is the basic foundation of our mutual relationships.

Jesus in today's Gospel shows us that our love comes from His love for us. Jesus loved us to the end; He made us worthy of love, worthy in sharing this received love. Jesus loved every man, even the most lost or compromised in our human eyes. That is why we are called to specific attitudes. It is not enough to simply tolerate another man, but you have to love him. It is not enough to do no harm to anyone, but you must do good to others as well. It is not enough to sympathize with someone, but you have to be able to wipe their tears.

It is left up to us to draw from the love of Jesus, to finally have and be able to share this precious gift, which is the love of Christ.

And now a few things I want you to know:

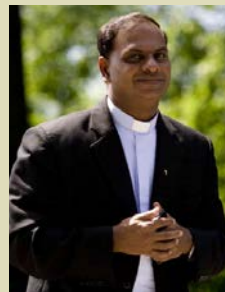

Healing Mass With Fr. Vadakkel



Fr. Dr. Joseph Vadakkel will be celebrating the next Healing Mass at SS. Cyril & Methodius Parish on Saturday, May 25th at 7:00PM. The Mass will be in English and the homily will be both in English and Polish.

Fr. Dr. Vadakkel is an appointed director of the Eucharistic Flame Evangelization for Europe and other countries by the Missionary Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament. He has held talks on the radio and has had a live TV program called Eucharistic Flame at the Divine Mercy Channel, conducted retreats, celebrated Holy Masses and healing Masses, and preached on the Montalban Prayer Mountain. Fr. Vadakkel has written two books entitled *Jesus Wipes Away Your Tears* and *Jesus—Your Eucharistic Flame*. Fr. Vadakkel received the apostolic blessing from Pope Benedict XVI for his Eucharistic Flame Mission in July, 2009.

Currently, Fr. Vadakkel spends most of his time in Europe carrying out his mission and conducting seminars and retreats for individual groups such as families, youth, priests and nuns as well as for Eucharistic Flame conventions.

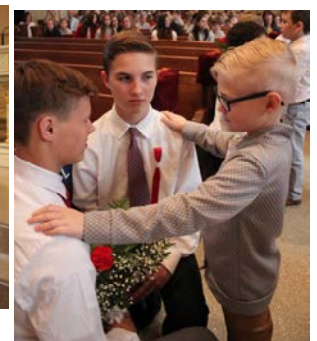

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION NEWS

Religious Education Registration Information for the 2019/2020 school year:**Families already enrolled in the Religious Education Program have until June 15th to register before their tuition increases.****Any new families wishing to register for Religious Education classes can do so after June 1st. Registration materials can be found in the back of church after June 1st or you can go online to our website www.stcyril.org and print off a registration form for new families.**

For your information the following are requirements for the religious education program:

1. In order for your child to make their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in second grade they must complete first grade.
2. In order for your child to make their Confirmation in 8th grade they must complete grades 3 – 7.
3. We ask that you become a registered supporting parishioner if you are registering your child for religious education classes. If you are not currently a registered parishioner please take care of registering for the parish now so it does not hold up your registration.
4. If you are transferring from another religious education program I must have a transfer form from your old parish stating what grades your child has completed.
5. Everest Academy, Noonan Academy, Kingswood Academy, home schooled students and anyone else who attend a non-archdiocesan school who wish to make their First Holy Communion or Confirmation at St. Cyril's are required to register for the Religious Education Program for the second and eighth grade years.

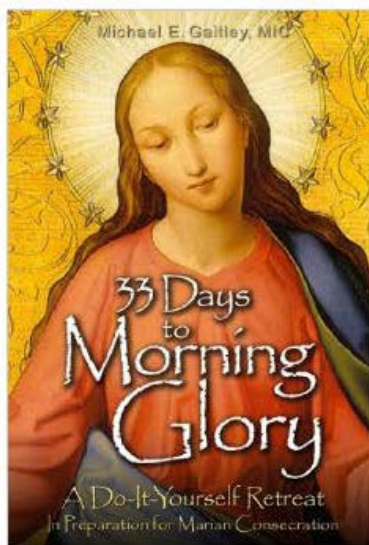

***Drodzy Parafianie,***

Dzisiaj słyszymy Jezusową mowę pożegnalną. Judasz powziął decyzję o zdradzie swojego Mistrza i konsekwentnie ją realizował, nie zważając i nie licząc się z jasnymi oraz konkretnymi gestami miłości ze strony Jezusa wobec niego. Najbliższy uczeń staje się zdrajcą. Judasz w tak jawny sposób odrzuca miłość Jezusa, a On prosi pozostałych uczniów, by się uczyli nowego przykazania wzajemnej miłości.

Jezus wobec swojego stworzenia objawił największą miłość. Za swoje stworzenie umarł na krzyżu. Jezusowi zależało, by w sercu poszczególnego człowieka wiary wyniszczyć egoizm i nienawiść, by w świecie mogło zapanować królestwo miłości.
